Using Green to Build a Community

Even though city-dwellers share intimate spaces with their neighbors, many homeowners don't have the faintest idea of the names of the people who live right next to them. Architects and developers for the Marley Park development in Surprise, Arizona, created a neighborhood that was designed to shine light on such anonymity and welcome its residents outdoors. With over 140 acres designated solely for "open space," such as parks, village clubs and school playgrounds, architects realized they would need experienced turf counsel and quality turf—lots of it. Western Sod, a subsidiary of Palm Desert, California-based West Coast Turf, provided Marley Park's architects with both.

West Coast Turf specializes in working with landscape architects to help meet a wide variety of project demands, analyzing project needs and helps specify turf varieties ideal for the application. Western Sod is the company's distribution/installation arm in the greater Phoenix area.

Getting to Know Your Neighbors

Marley Park is a 956-acre planned community created by architect EDAW, a global design company, and DMB Associates, Inc., a real estate development and investment firm headquartered in Scottsdale, Arizona. Ground was broken in October 2003 and Western Sod has been a valued consultant and provider in the turf needs of the community since then. Designed to be a livable, walkable community, Marley Park has several diverse, themed parks that serve not only the varying recreational needs of the community but also provide areas for larger organized play, community celebrations and gatherings.

EDAW and DMB's goal was to create connections between neighborhoods within Marley Park by incorporating as much greenery and turf into the design as possible. Architects have planned Marley Park's development to be completed in five phases and will utilize these green concepts at every stage. Marley Park's Phase I development, which is nearing completion, is primary evidence of this connectivity. Phase I features lush greenery surrounding streets, boulevards, linear parkways, pathways and trails, inviting residents to come outside and enjoy their beauty. Inspired by classical landscapes, landscape architects have attempted to create distinctive memorable places for neighbors to get to know one another.

Phase I of Marley Park contains nine parks that are each uniquely themed with playgrounds, covered picnic areas, flower beds, shade trees and open play areas. By centering its community around its green, open spaces, architects have built Marley Park to be unlike any other neighborhood in Arizona's Northwest Valley.

Sod Selection Crucial for Future Needs

With Marley Park's emphasis on open, community congregation, the team realized early in the planning for Marley Park that they would need sod that could accommodate for the high traffic demands placed on the parks and open spaces. In addressing turf needs for Heritage Park, one of the nine parks planned for Phase I, landscape contractors AAA Landscape found what they were looking for when they selected Western Sod. Michael Walter, vice president of construction at AAA Landscape who oversaw the landscape construction for Heritage Park, said AAA selected Western Sod based on its turf quality, timeliness and willingness to meet the needs of their customers.

Western Sod Steps Up to the Challenge

Jay Danek, sales representative for Western Sod, said the selection of turf for Heritage Park was based on the developers plan's for the community.

"Given the use of the turf and the area's high temperatures, we thought Western Sod's EZ Turf—or MidIron Bermudagrass—would be a perfect solution," said Danek. "EZ Turf withstands high traffic, holds up to extreme temperatures and doesn't take a heavy toll on water and maintenance budgets."

Heritage Park included 17 acres of EZ Turf, which Western Sod installed. Danek said the sod laid in Heritage Park was contained on large rolls that measured 42 inches by 110 feet long. Over two, two-week periods, 12 Western Sod workers installed between



80,000 to 100,000 square feet of sod every day. Given the amount of work it took to install the quantity of turf required by Marley Park developers, one could see how it would take a special crew to handle this job.

"Despite the challenges of installing Marley Park's turf, it allowed us to showcase perfectly what we're able to accomplish every day in order to get the job done," Danek said.

Gage said her firm couldn't be more satisfied with Western Sod's performance and selection for sod.
